

# **Sailing Areas**

#### Area A 1

European inland waters, rivers and canals, waters of the Baltic Sea, Kattegat and Skagerrak, North Sea, English Channel - with the boundaries running:

- from the town of Thurso in the north of Scotland along the islands of Orkney and Shetland on the western side (three-mile zone) and continuing in a straight line to the entrance of the Trondheim Fjord, whereby travel in the Trondheim Fjord is also insured.
- 2) in a straight line from Land's End in the south of England, crossing the English Channel to the town of Brest on the continent.

### Area A

as described under A 1 extending to include the Irish Sea as well as the adjacent waters of the Atlantic up to 65° North, 30° West and 20° North; the Mediterranean including the entire coast of North Africa, the Canary Islands, Madeira and the Azores, straits as well as the Dardanelles, the Black Sea and the Sea of Asov.

### Area B

as described under A, waters of the Atlantic up to 40° South without any limitation to the west, including the adjacent waters of North America and Canada as well as the Caribbean.

## Area C

Worldwide. This area is only insurable subject to prior written agreement.
